## **BLOOM'S REVISED TAXONOMY**

Using the updated **Bloom Taxonomy**, we can create questions around the 6 levels, starting from the lowest level to the higher order thinking skill:

Creating Generation of viewing things		Designing, constructing, planning, producing, inventing.	Compose an engineering song, skit, and poem or rap to convey the story in a new form.
Evaluating Justifying a decision or course of action		Checking, hypothesising, critiquing, experimenting, judging	Assess whether or not you think this really happened.
Analysing Breaking information int parts to explore understandings and relationships	tO	Comparing, organising, deconstructing, interrogating, finding	Differentiate between how the child reacted and how you would react in each story event.
Applying Using information in and familiar situation	other	Implementing, carrying out, using, executing	Construct a theory as to why this was special for the child.
Understand Explaining ideas or con		Interpreting, summarising, paraphrasing, classifying, explaining	Summarize what the story was about.
Rememberi Recalling information	ng	Recognising, listing, describing, retrieving, naming, finding	Describe where this took place.
